New Properties Finders Fee

It is the policy of the WEGM to reward its members with a finders fee for locating new properties for the club to lease. The member will be paid \$240 or receive credit for \$240 in membership dues upon the club approving the lease for club use. The member must act as an agent between the landowner and the WEGM. To receive the finders fee, you must register in writing with the club secretary your intent to begin discussing a proposed lease with the landowner. You cannot receive the finders fee unless registration is complete and the lease is approved by the WEGM.

STANDING RULES

- 1. No use of alcohol on Association outings.
- Smoking will not be permitted at Association meetings or activities unless held in the open air.
- Members are expected to adhere to the Association's Code of Ethics while prospecting or mining
- Members are expected to conduct themselves at all times in accordance with the laws of the land and reasonable moral behavior
- Violation of Standing Rules will result in disciplinary action as determined by the Executive Board of Directors
- The President, Vice-President or their appointed spokesperson(s) are the only people authorized to speak on behalf of the WEGM
- Regular monthly meetings will be held on the first Saturday of each month at a scheduled time as stated in the club newsletter and website

Lease property gate locks will be changed April 1, 2020. New keys will be mailed out on March 15, 2020 to all members that have their dues and fees paid up to date, for those that are not sent a key, when you get your dues and fees up to date then you will be sent a new key. President David Zimmerman opened up the floor for discussion:

There were several discussions on how to generate more money for the club. A key fee for the new keys that are sent out when the gate locks are changed. # 3323 Terry Newman ask about the \$50 key Fee that was brought up at a previous meeting. President David Zimmerman said that adding a fee other than a maintenance fee would have to be put to vote to the whole membership by ballot vote. This would be a costly, around \$600 with only a handful of members returning a ballot. We send out over 800 election ballots and only receive about 150 back.

#3323 Terry Newman made a motion to add a key fee to every member in the club. # 2533 Bill Quick seconded. David said that the motion could not be passed because the vote had to go to the full membership by ballot. He did have the member's present do a show of hands vote to see their opinion on a key fee. Most all were in favor.

They discussed sending a letter to all the members that were grandfathered in when the maintenance fee of \$25 was approved and ask if they would be willing to pay or donate a \$50 maintenance fee, one time only. This letter could be sent out with the keys next month or with election ballot in June.

David said that we wouldn't be able to implement a key fee until next year due to the timing of getting it approved by the full membership.




